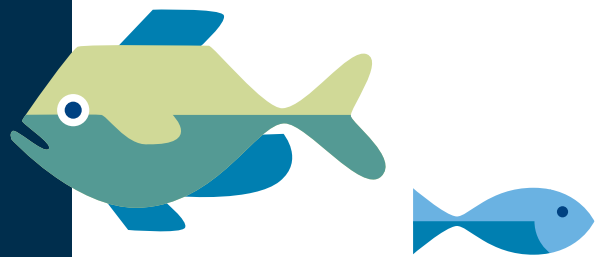




PORT NIKAU CELEBRATES SEAWEEK 2018

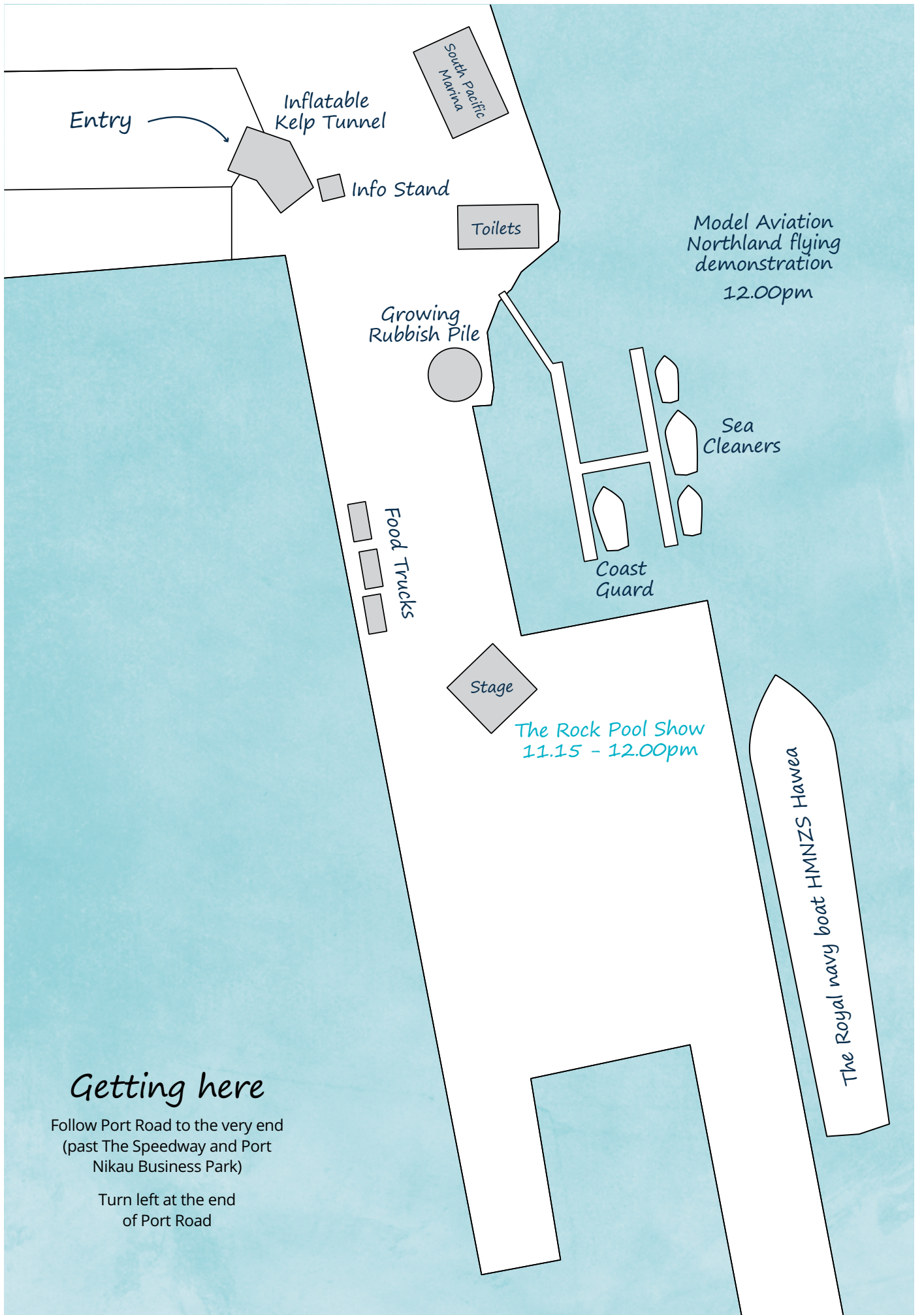
